The FELLOW OF FPSC™ distinction was established for the purpose of recognizing individuals who have made a significant contribution to the profession of financial planning in Canada. As a FELLOW OF FPSC™, the work of these individuals reflects their commitment to ethics that form the foundation of CFP certification standards upon which the financial planning profession is built.

The granting of the FELLOW OF FPSC™ distinction is based on nominees fulfilling both of the criteria outlined below:

1. Volunteering or Related Activity with FPSC

They have a proven track record and / or long-standing history of volunteering with FPSC and / or volunteerism that is directly related to advancing FPSC's purpose of instilling confidence in the financial planning profession and / or FPSC's mandate or Vision 2020. "Volunteering" does not include activities directly related to their job. They demonstrate passion and commitment to FPSC's purpose and are recognized as a role model by other volunteers.

2. Advancement of CFP professional standards

They play (or have played) a leading or inspiring role in developing or expanding the acceptance or adoption of CFP professional standards. The work they have done in this area has or will further the public interest and enhance the reputation of CFP certification.

Suffice to say, the FELLOW OF FPSC™ distinction is truly earned by those who receive it.

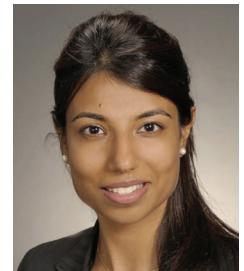
